Birthdays

Please let your child's teacher know if you wish for them to NOT have any treats provided by parents and / or the teacher.

On-site Opportunities

We will begin to hold our K-2 assembly in the hall, again. This is a formal assembly where students are recognised for their efforts and successes. Each class also gets an opportunity to show off their reading and presentation skills, as well as perform a short item, for all K-2 students, teachers and visitors. This assembly runs from 12:50-1:30 every fortnightly Friday (odd school weeks) and we invite visitors from Friday 24 March 2022. We will let you know which class will be hosting and performing prior to the assembly day. Please note that we do not require proof of vaccination for these visits.
