NAPLAN Online

The school readiness test is now complete. Between 14 August – 22 September, around 318,000 students from 2,832 NSW schools participated in around 517,000 tests.

78% of students who completed the combined literacy and numeracy test say that they liked using a computer to do the test, and 75% of students who completed the writing test say the same.

So far, the NAPLAN Online transition team have received survey responses from over 2,200 NSW schools who participated in the test.

Of the schools who have completed the survey:

- 86% indicate a level of confidence in transitioning to NAPLAN Online
- 90% feel students were “somewhat”, “mostly” or “very much” more engaged with the online omnibus test compared to the pen and paper version
- 78% feel students were “somewhat”, “mostly” or “very much” more engaged with the online writing test compared to the pen and paper version

School and student feedback from the readiness test will help further inform the transition of NSW schools to NAPLAN Online by 2019.
