Attending School

I would like to remind families that children are required to attend school each day it is open for students. This includes being at school on time and staying until the end of the day.

On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick, or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstance (e.g. attending a funeral)

Following an absence from school you must ensure that within 7 days you provide your child's school with a verbal or written explanation for the absence. However, if the school has not received an explanation from you within 2 days, the school may contact you to discuss the absence.

Families are encouraged to travel during school holidays. If travel during school term is necessary, discuss this with your child's school principal. An *Application for Extended Leave* may need to be completed. Absences relating to travel will be marked as leave on the roll and therefore contribute to your child's total absences for the year.

Please contact the school if you have any questions about leave.

L3 Training

Four of our Stage One teachers will be undertaking Language, Learning and Literacy (L3) training this year. Our other Early Stage One and Stage One teachers have successfully completed their training and are now implementing L3 into their classrooms. Language, Learning and Literacy (L3) is an effective research-based literacy program. L3 supports the development of informed, systematic, explicit instruction based on data to target reading and writing. Teachers undertake professional learning under a qualified trainer to develop literacy learning plans and targeted teaching that reflects individual student learning needs, and is based on ongoing data collection. They learn techniques for planning and delivering instruction to small groups and to the whole class. Trainers support teachers' developing pedagogies by giving feedback and reflecting collaboratively, using regular classroom observations.



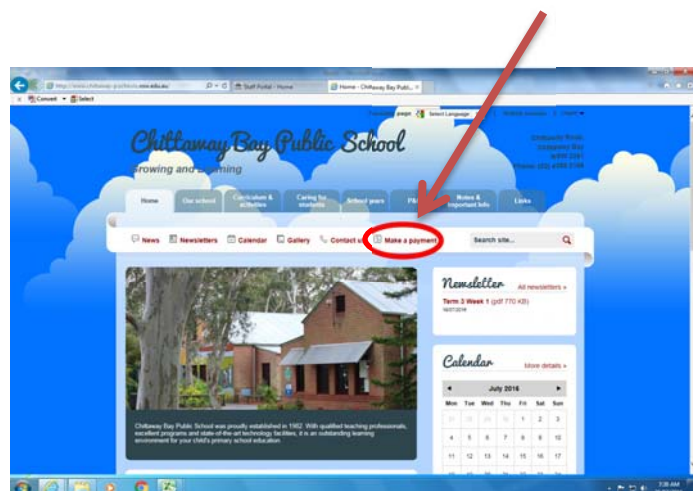

Online payments

Just a reminder that we now accept online payments (**not for the uniform shop**) using the Department of Education's Parent Online Payment (POP) system. A button to access this new online payment system titled '\$ Make a Payment' will be visible on the utility bar on the front page of our school's website at www.chittaway-p.schools.nsw.edu.au. By selecting this link, parents and carers will be taken to a secure Westpac QuickWeb payment page from which they can make online payments.

Please note: As a Westpac-hosted solution cardholder and account details will be held securely helping to protect the school and its customers from fraudulent transactions as well as assisting in meeting the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCIDSS) compliance requirements.

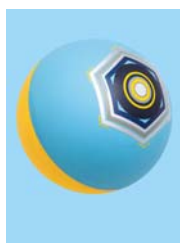
