## Anzac Day @ The Entrance, Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2017

This year we once again invite students and their families to gather at the Anzac Day Memorial Service at The Entrance. Mrs Flaxman and Miss O'Sullivan will meet students at the corner opposite Memorial Park (near KFC) to observe the March Past at 11.30am. ## **Year 5 opportunity class placement in 2018**

Opportunity classes cater for highly achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These classes help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for opportunity class placement are considered mainly on the combined results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test and school assessments. The Opportunity Class Placement Test will be held on **Wednesday 26 July 2017**.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2018, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from **26 April 2017** in a printed application information booklet and at <https://education.nsw.gov.au/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-5>. The application website opens on **26 April 2017** and closes on **Friday 12 May 2017**. No late applications will be accepted.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after **26 April 2017**.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

Important dates are as follows:

**Wednesday 26 April 2017:** Online applications open

**Friday 12 May 2017:** Online applications close

**Wednesday 26 July 2017:** Opportunity Class Placement Test

## **Treatment of head lice**

Head lice are a very common problem that most parents and teachers are more than familiar with. The school holidays are a great time to treat your child for head lice, just before they come back to school for Term 2. Here are some treatment tips:

- Do not treat your child if their scalp is irritated or inflame.
- Always read the head lice product label and directions before you apply it to your child's head.  
Products can be found in local chemists
- Apply the head lice product to every strand of your child's hair and work through, leave for 20 minutes, and comb out with a good quality lice comb
- Check your child's head and if dead lice are found, the product has worked. However make sure you re-treat your child's head in seven days to catch nymphs that have emerged from unhatched eggs



- Reduce the risk of your child catching head lice by tying their hair back or braiding it.

## Cyber Safe

Children often spend more time on the internet during the holidays and it is important to support our children to keep them safe. Here are a few tips about keeping children safe on the net:

- Be involved in your child's life – dedicate time to really understand your child. Know where they are, who they are with and what they are doing.
- Be cyber-aware: regularly monitor what they are looking at on the internet and on social media sites and do what you can to reduce their exposure to inappropriate content;
- place the computer or device in a common area of the house, so your child is less likely to try and access inappropriate web sites or use social media sites inappropriately; and
- consider using content filters to help control what your child can access.

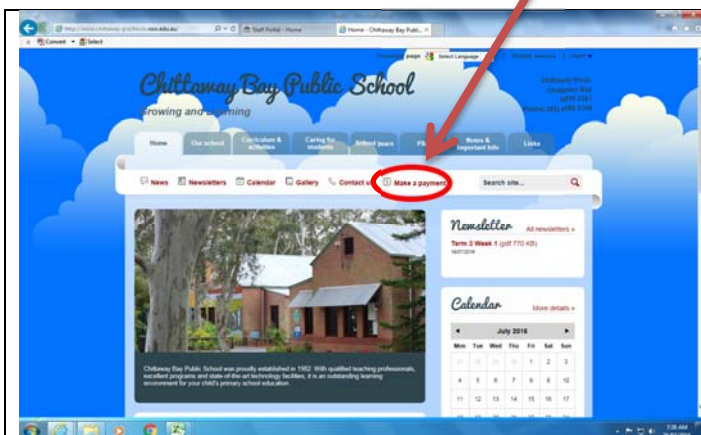
#### **Online payments**

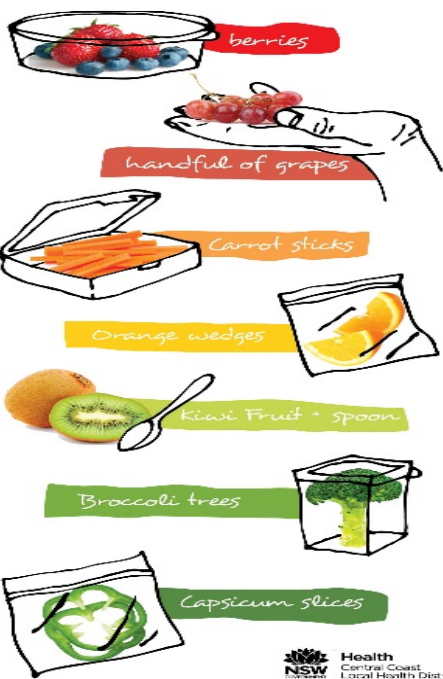
