School App

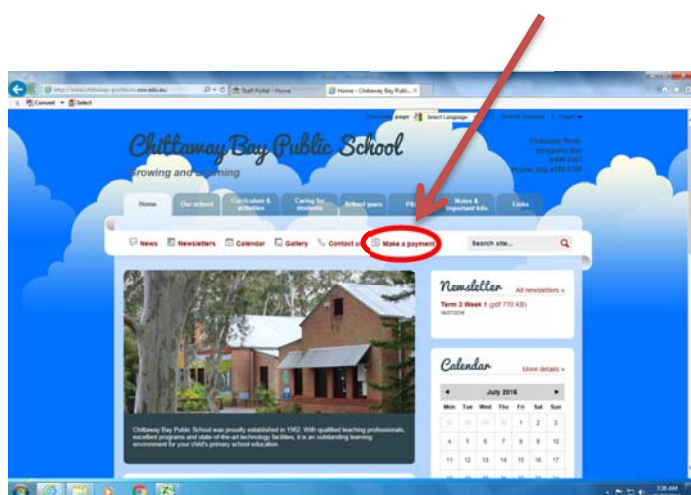

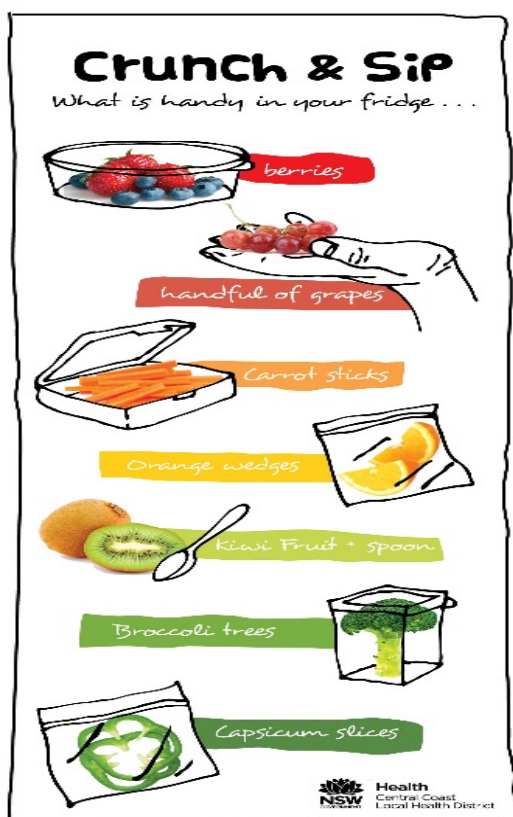
