School App

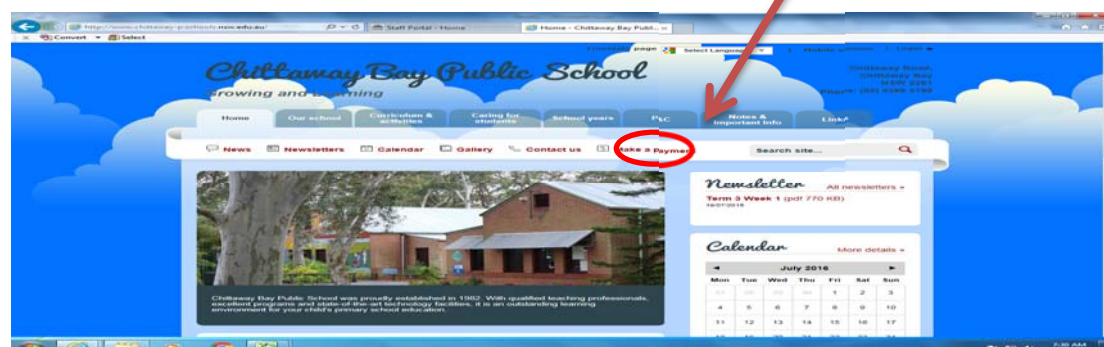

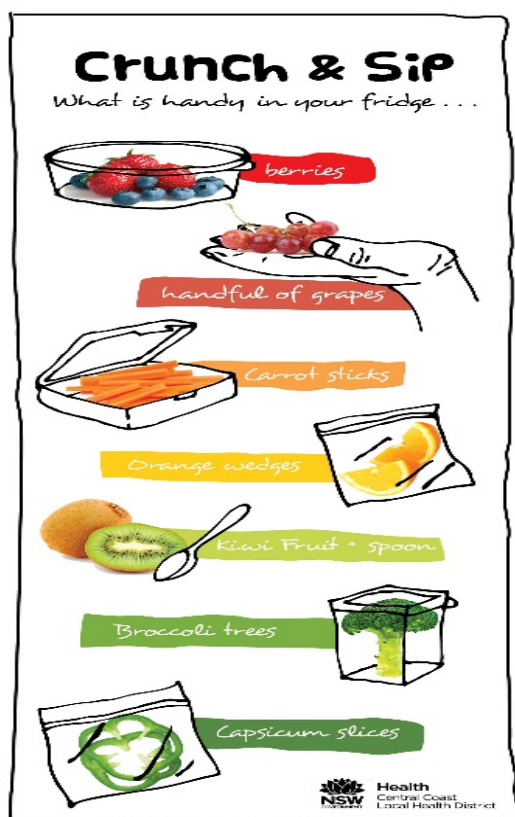
