Food Allergy Week runs from 14–20 May 2017 and calls on all Australians to Be Aware and Show You Care. Each year at Chittaway Bay PS staff take part in mandatory Anaphylaxis training.

- Walking with them the whole way to school

Regular exercise like walking with your child not only helps them (and you!) beat chronic problems like obesity, heart disease, behavioural and mental health issues and diabetes. It also gives you a great opportunity to teach your child safe ways to behave around roads and traffic.

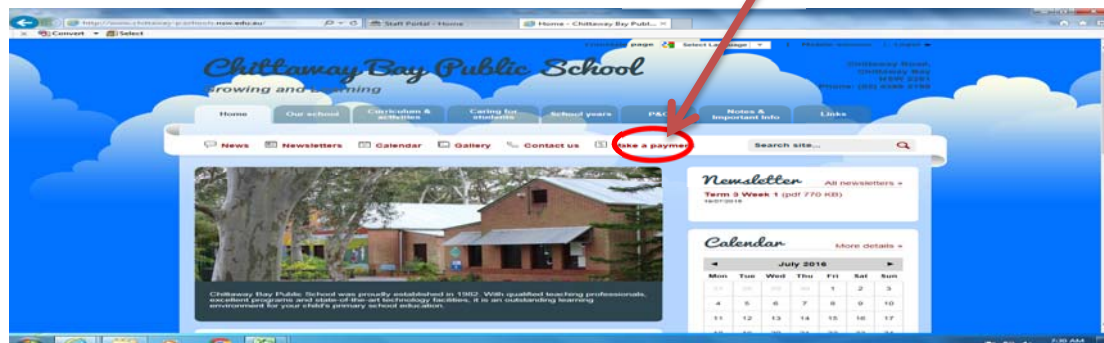
Online payments

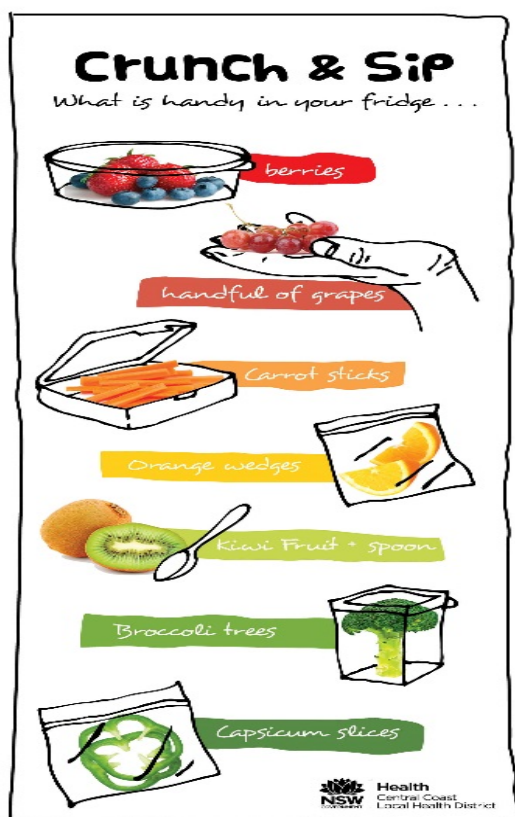
