Treatment of head lice

Head lice are a very common problem that most parents and teachers are more than familiar with. The school holidays is a great time to treat your child for head lice, just before they come back to school for Term 4. Here are some treatment tips:

- Do not treat your child if their scalp is irritated or inflamed
- Always read the head lice product label and directions before you apply it to your child's head. Products can be found in local chemists
- Apply the head lice product to every strand of your child's hair and work through, leave for 20 minutes, and comb out with a good quality lice comb
- Check your child's head and if dead lice are found, the product has worked. However make sure you re-treat your child's head in seven days to catch nymphs that have emerged from unhatched eggs
- Reduce the risk of your child catching head lice by tying their hair back or braiding it.

Cyberwise – Protecting your child's digital reputation

Children, especially during their teenage years, learn the importance of their reputation as a part of growing up. Offline, a child's reputation can be established through behaviour in the classroom and the playground, their treatment of friends, and academic, artistic or sporting achievements. Your child's online reputation is defined by both the content they post about themselves and what others post about your child.

Tagged photos, blog posts and social networking interactions will all shape how your child is perceived online and offline. A poor digital reputation can affect friendships, relationships and future job prospects.

Children can protect their digital reputation by:

- * Thinking before they post. Does everything about their life really need to be online? How might this affect them in the future?
- * Setting their profile to private and checking privacy settings regularly to make sure default options haven't changed. This will allow them to [control](#) who sees what they post online. Visit the eSafety [website](#) for more information on how to protect your child's privacy online. The eSafety website has a section on [games, apps and social networking](#) with step-by-step instructions to control your settings for each social networking platform.
- * Keeping an eye on photos tagged by friends. Even if your child's profile is private, the content friends post might be available for the world to see. Some social media sites allow users to approve tags before they are attached to their profile.

Thank you, Lois and Robbie for displaying good sportsmanship.

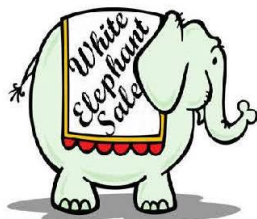

Donations can be dropped to the school from Tuesday 10 October at any time during school operating hours. All items must be in good working order.

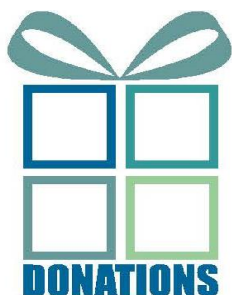

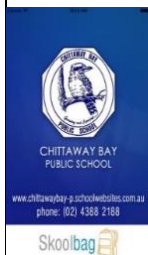

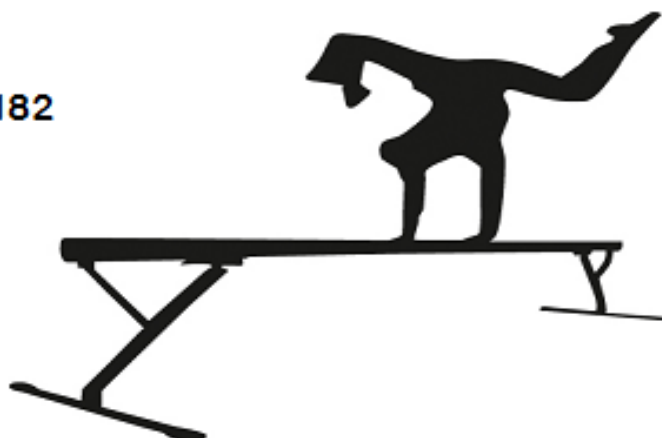
