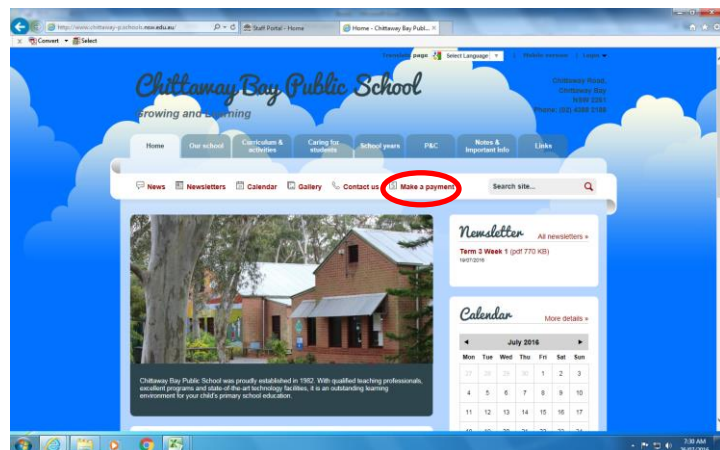

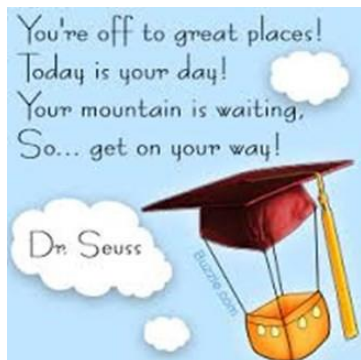
Online payments

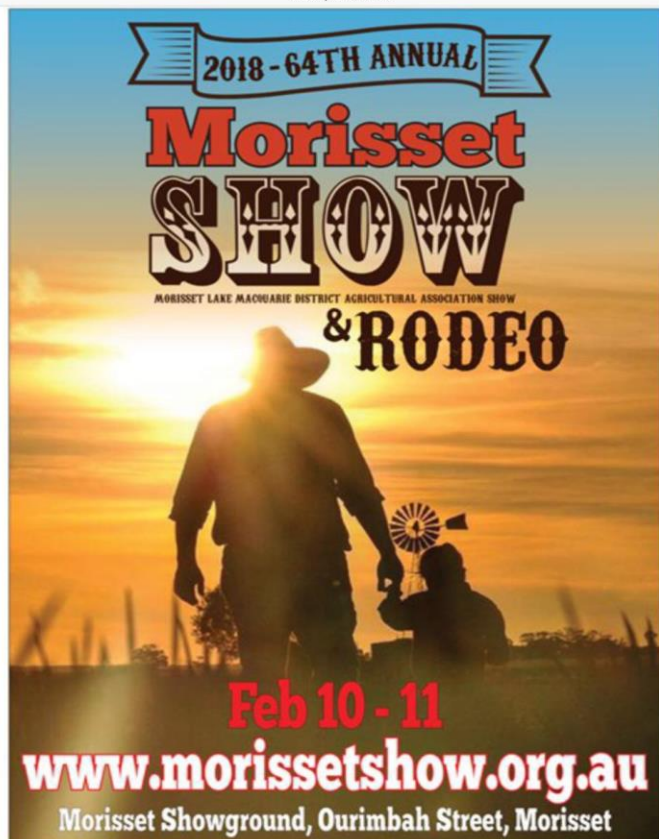
